Below is a large collection of free jucool tabs for a variety of skills and styles. All of them are created (and in several cases, checked) by me with an eye on detail and accuracy. In each section of the song's tablata is colored by complexity: Rock/Pop/Ukulele Tabs: These songs can often be found elsewhere, transcribed for guitar, but not necessarily organized or tabs for the jucele. My uke specific interpretations follow. Ukulele/Hawaiian Instrumental Instruments: Songs found here are mostly juquel as a leading instrument. So most of the tunes from Hawaii-based artists I grew up listening to and imitating. For me, it's Hawaiian standards, if not on song, then in style. If you want to explore Hawaiian sound, this is the section for you. Hawaiian: Common Goals Hawaiian Songs with Lyrics are served here. Jazz/Bossa: Reggae Ukulele Tabs: Soundtrack/ Topics: Folk/World: Since many of the folk songs people make ukulele tabs for are in the public domain, it's pretty easy to find high quality, professional transcription. (Other genres always run the risk of being filmed on copyright basis.) Ken Middleton is an effective arranger like no one and has a collection of free bluegrass and Celtic style tabs available. He has also published several e-books of transcriptions. Classics: PDF Minstrel provides a wide range of large classic jucoal tabs. Traditional: Christmas: † - Tab Herb Ohta Jr. †† - Tab by Jeremy Reynolds - Tab Glenn Reiter These ukulele tabs are in a PDF format created with Guitar Pro, Powertab, or Good Ol 'Microsoft Word. The lead sheet Tabs are transcriptions of Guitar Pro melody, words (if applicable) and chords. The Fingerstyle solo arrangement tabs shown below include a melody intertwined with chords designed to play a single player and imply harmony and lead at the same time. These are my own interpretations, not necessarily a transcription of a particular performance. I try to keep them as easy as possible because I feel it's easier to add your own flavor than to sift through someone else's style. Note for transcription notes are tabs of a particular record jucler and are transcribed as accurately as possible. What is the Ukulele tab? Tablature (or Tab for Short) is a simple system of notes. It uses numbers on the lines to represent the frets and strings of the ukulele. the advantage of tabs over a piece of standard music is that there is very little learning curve. If you can count you can play with the tab. Each tab system consists of four horizontal lines: ----- E ----- C (-----) G (-----) As you can see by the names of the rows on each line, the top line represents line A, and the bottom line represents the G-string. C and E-strings sit between them. Think of it as a rolling uke and down flat on your knees. Numbers placed on the lines show which frets to click down and read from left to right. (0 means open line.) A -----0--- E (-----0---) C (----0-----) G --0----- This shows open strings plucked one from the top row down. A---3-5-7-3--- E (-----) C (-----) G (-----) The above example is all played on the A-string: 3rd fret, 5th rook, 7th fret, 3rd rook. Anytime you see numbers stacked vertically you have to play them simultaneously as a chord. Here's C: A ---3--- E--0--- S---0--- G---0--- For much more, check out this guide to reading the tab for a better understanding of lines, numbers and characters. Where to find more free ukulele tabs there are many custom tab sites that get a ton of traffic, such as massive ukulele-tabs.com and even massive-er ultimate-guitar.com. While you can find most of any song, keep in mind that the quality of these tabs vary depending on the skill of the transcriber. However, there are many really great sources of free jucler tabs out there! My favorites for top-notch transcriptions are: Ukeeducation.org - A large collection of simple chord tunes. Ukulele Hunt - Al Wood does a good job of covering riffs and intro/outros for many pop/punk/rock songs. They usually include video examples/textbooks. Other tab/resources articles here are some links to information regarding how to read the tab and other related articles. Transform guitars and high/low G tabs to customize you're playing in - How to move numbers around so you can play a tab that isn't necessarily designed to be customized. Every ukulele player should have some cool cool riffs in the back pocket. In this article you will learn the 10 best riffs to impress your friends and add variety to your repertoire. When you first start playing the ukulele, you'll most likely learn four main chords - C, G, Am and F. If you have a pen for these four chords, you'll be able to play tons of songs. But once you get comfortable playing songs, you want to spice up your repertoire. One easy way to do this is to incorporate ukulele riffs into your game. The ukulele riff is a series of notes played in a song that creates a catchy melody. The riff can be played as a sample of a single string of notes, or as a series of chords. Often the riff is repeated several times throughout the song and is easily recognizable.10 Cool Ukulele Riffs to learn TodayEventually, you'll be able to choose riffs by ear, but when you're just starting out it helps to have tab notes for you. Ukulele tabs are an easy way to learn music tunes, even if you can't read music. Keep in mind that tabs don't usually include timelines of how long to play each note. (It will help if you have heard these riffs at some point in your life, so you will know the rhythm). The tabs also won't tell you which fingers to use to play each note. Shave and haircutThis's quick riff was made popular in the late 80s, semi-animated film Who Framed Roger Rabbit. 2. Weak from SWVThis fun riff repeated over and over throughout the song. Like many ukulele riffs, this one has been moved to a key that matches the ukulele while maintaining the integrity of the melody line. (I Can't Get No) Satisfaction the Rolling StonesThis opening riff plays guitar on the original recording. Because of the ukulele setting, the tab below is written so that the melody is played higher than the original key.4. Bob Marley's song No Woman No Cry simply requires knowledge of the four main chords of the ukulele (C, G, Am and F). The turn around the riff follows the chords. The eye of the tiger from SurvivorOne of the most popular, cool ukulele riffs is the discovery of the Eye of the Tiger. It's a surefire way to turn an ordinary ukulele into a rock 'n' roll machine. Below are two different versions of the opening riff. Or... 6. Charlie Brown Theme SongA is a classic riff that was played on piano, guitar and now ukulele. All the notes are on one line (above the 5th fret), making this riff a light riff that you can learn to play today.7. La Bamba by Richie Walea This opening riff is the longest riff on this list. It's also a little more complicated than everyone else because of the frequent change of strings in the melody. This is a fun task for beginner ukulele players who will help with finger coordination and speed.8. Theme Friends MusicIf you are an enthusiast of friends, it's the ukulele riff you've been waiting for. In the popular TV series, there are reprises of original theme music that are used to help transition between scenes. This is one of those transitions that is used frequently. 9. The Simpsons Theme SongThere two tab version of this popular riff below. First, in the original way. Due to the limitations of the note on the ukulele, the last four notes of the riff should go up, not down. The second version is a rescheduled version of the riff. It has the same intervals as the original melody, where the last four notes go down. Like most music, it's up to the individual artist to decide which version they prefer best. 10. Beverly Hills Cop Theme SongThis catchy ukulele riff has a great rhythm and you can learn to play the day. Also, most of your friends have heard this riff, and even hummed it time (or 10).
